

Florida's January Figures Released

Florida's seasonally adjusted unemployment rate was 3.1 percent in January 2024, unchanged from the revised December 2023 rate, and up 0.3 percentage point from a year ago. There were 340,000 jobless Floridians out of a labor force of 11,077,000. The U.S. seasonally adjusted unemployment rate was 3.7 percent in January.

Florida's seasonally adjusted total nonagricultural employment was 9,904,600 in January 2024, an increase of 38,800 jobs (+0.4 percent) over the month. The state gained 259,600 jobs over the year, an increase of 2.7 percent. Nationally, the number of jobs rose 1.9 percent over the year.

Florida's Nonagricultural Employment by Industry (Seasonally Adjusted)

- Nine of ten major industries experienced positive over-the-year job growth in January.
- The industries gaining jobs over the year included education and health services (+67,100 jobs, +4.6 percent); trade, transportation, and utilities (+56,600 jobs, +2.9 percent); leisure and hospitality (+35,600 jobs, +2.8 percent); total government (+28,300 jobs, +2.5 percent); construction (+27,200 jobs, +4.4 percent); professional and business services (+12,600 jobs, +0.8 percent); other services (+11,900 jobs, +3.3 percent); financial activities (+11,100 jobs, +1.6 percent); and manufacturing (+10,900 jobs, +2.6 percent).
- The only major industry losing jobs over the year was information (-1,900 jobs, -1.2 percent).

Local Area Unemployment Statistics (Not Seasonally Adjusted)

- In January 2024, Miami-Dade County had the state's lowest unemployment rate (1.4 percent), followed by Monroe County (2.1 percent), and Collier County, Okaloosa County, St. Johns County, Seminole County and Wakulla County (3.0 percent each).
- Citrus County had the highest unemployment rate (5.2 percent) in Florida in January 2024, followed by Sumter County (5.0 percent), and Highlands County and Taylor County (4.7 percent each).

Area Nonagricultural Employment (Not Seasonally Adjusted)

- In January 2024, 23 of 24 metro areas in Florida had over-the-year job gains. The areas with the largest gains were the Miami-Miami Beach-Kendall MD (+47,000 jobs, +3.7 percent), followed by the Tampa-Saint Petersburg-Clearwater MSA (+34,400 jobs, +2.3 percent), and the Orlando-Kissimmee-Sanford MSA (+31,000 jobs, +2.2 percent).
- The Homosassa Springs MSA lost jobs over the year in January 2024 (-100 jobs, -0.3 percent).

The unemployment and job growth rates are estimates, which are primarily based on surveys created and mandated by the U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics in cooperation with the Florida Department of Commerce.

The unemployment rate is derived from Florida household surveys conducted by the U.S. Census Bureau under contract with the U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics. The job growth rate is derived from Florida employer surveys conducted by the U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics.

Both estimates are revised on a monthly basis. In addition, these estimates are benchmarked (revised) annually based on actual counts from Florida's Reemployment Assistance tax records and other data.
